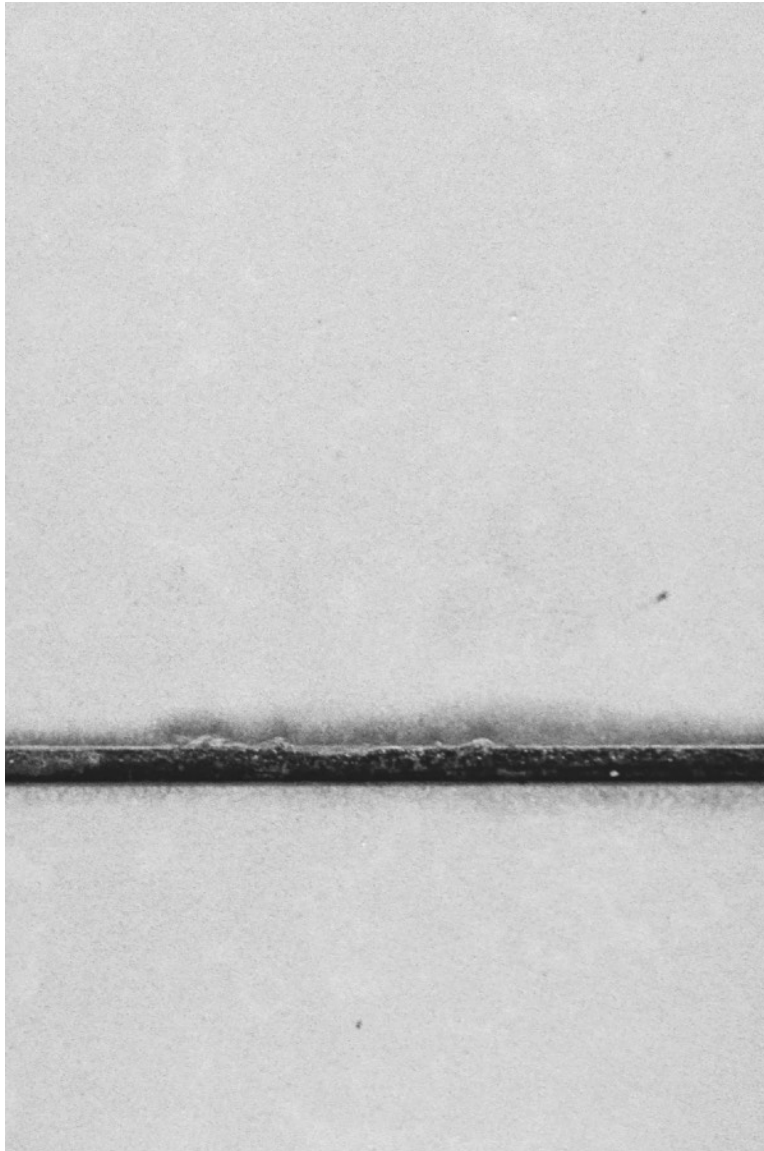

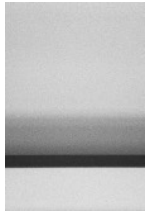

'Photographic Paintings' transforms ordinary details that might go unnoticed into abstract compositions. The aim is to make each subject so unfamiliar that its original context in the photograph becomes unrecognizable. New York, in particular, is full of construction sites featuring patched-up walls, stained concrete, and intriguing lines on the ground that often escape notice. By merging elements of painting and photography, the intention is for each image to resemble a distinct abstract painting.

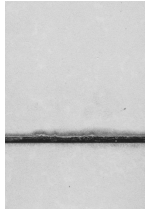
This book goes behind the creation of the body of work, explaining the context and process behind these photographs and how they relate back to the world of painting.

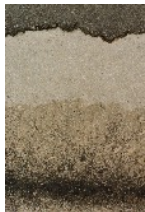

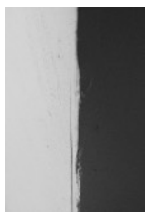
